## Miami City Ballet's Don Quixote Performances at Kravis Center March 20-22 postponed and Miami City Ballet School Closure Begins Friday, March 13, 2020 at 5pm

Miami, FL (March 13, 2020) – Miami City Ballet (MCB) believes the health and safety of its company dancers, MCB School students, support staff, audiences, and the community-at-large are a top priority. In response to the COVID-19 pandemic and Florida's recent State of Emergency declaration, Miami City Ballet (MCB) will close all MCB School and Community Engagement related classes and activities beginning March 13, 2020 at 5pm. Classes and regularly scheduled activities are set to resume Monday, April 13, 2020.

Executive Director Tania Castroverde Moskalenko adds, "We know the public health situation our community and the world are facing is unsettling and our thoughts are with those affected by the COVID-19 virus. While it is disappointing to postpone performances and classes, the health and safety of all those in our community is truly of our utmost concern."

MCB's 2020 Gala scheduled for Saturday, March 14 at the Miami Beach Convention Center is postponed until further notice.

MCB's upcoming performances of *Don Quixote* scheduled for **Friday, March 20-March 22** at the **Kravis Center in West Palm Beach** are also postponed until further notice. MCB's remaining performances of *Don Quixote* at the Arsht Center (April 17-19) and at the Broward Center (April 25-26) are currently still scheduled.
